The Grainger Wind Symphony Conducting Program 2024 Conducting Workshop Wednesday 27th March 6.30pm-10.15pm

INFORMATION

Applications are invited to participate the **Conducting Workshop** conducting the Grainger Wind Symphony, a community concert band that enthusiastically supports the development of young conductors. A conductor mentor will be allocated to support you one-on-one or in a class. Through this evening workshop, we expect conductors to gain confidence in what musical leadership they can provide on the podium.

Wednesday 6.30pm to 10.15pm 27th March at Blackburn High School Music Centre. This workshop is presented by The Grainger Wind Symphony.

Conductors can learn the following:

- need to gain experience in conducting when they are nervous
- starting and stopping an ensemble through using non-verbal gestures
- showing expressive devices in their conducting
- understand and conduct the features of the score
- reflect on their conducting skills through discussion with mentor on the night and
- review of the video of your podium time after.

The conducting teaching is based on what questions, issues and works each conducting participant brings to the workshop. There are many possibilities in conducting, explore these with a mentor.

- Conductors bring the band score (and a full set of band parts) to work on music they are preparing to conduct this year OR they learn excerpts from two or three set works
- Conductors can discuss ways to lead their ensemble using conducting techniques and rehearsal techniques, and trying them out with a live group.

What is the difference between selecting a One-On-One Mentor Program or the Class Program?

One-On-One Mentor Program - A number of very experienced conducting mentors have been engaged. All have worked in secondary schools and as conductors of a wind symphony/concert band. The mentor will provide a private one-on-one tutorial for one hour, then it will be followed by about 15 minutes podium time conducting The Grainger Wind Symphony with the support of your mentor, finishing with a short evaluation review. The podium time will be videoed. The mentors' biographies are posted on the website link below. Roland can help team you up with a mentor. Full Conducting Participants bring their own score of a concert band work, a second copy of the score, a full set of parts and a recording.

The conductor mentors for the One-On-One Program are:

Lynette Bridgland, Stephen Carpenter, Jo Heaton, Shane Walterfang.

Class Program - a maximum of four full participants each workshop who elect this program will conduct two or three excerpts from set works: Symphony No.2 3rd movement by Frank Ticheli, or First Suite in E Flat by Gustav Holst (ed.Matthews). Your mentor would be Roland Yeung, Music Director and Principal Conductor of The Grainger Wind Symphony. The Class will meet one evening the week prior for two hours at a date to be negotiated. The Class

Program will work on selected excerpts to master specific conducting techniques; EG. stopping and starting; conducting fractional beats, accents and pauses; changing tempo, cueing and conductor's posture and movement. The podium time will be videoed.

Number of places

In each workshop there is a limit of places for Full Conducting Participants. There is no limit for the number of Observers. In all there will be seven places in the workshop, to give sufficient podium time to each conductor. It is desirable to have up to four One-On-One Full Participant Conductors and up to three Class program Conductors at each workshop, no more than 7 in all having tutorial and podium time. First to complete the application forms and book on TryBooking will be given a place if not fully subscribed.
